- Commit zero conversion of natural ecosystems and no hunting except for subsistence or cultural traditions.
- Manage waste and emissions generated during the upstream and downstream operations.
- Inculcate, educate and train employees on the importance of protecting the environment through our policies and practices; and evoke their voluntary participation and cooperation.
- Periodically review this Environmental Policy for continuous improvement and ensure it remains relevant and applicable for the business.
